
MISSOURI MIS

RECERTIFICATION OPTION 1

- Expected time commitment is 9
 hours to complete the whole course.

Alternative Teaching Recertification Pathway

RECERTIFICATION OPTION 2

This alternative path to recertification will be available Fall 2023. The Online Teaching Essentials sprint will be required, and participants will select two additional <u>sprint mini-courses</u> to fit their individual needs and interests.

Three sprints are required for recertification:



All sprints are:

- Self-paced in Canvas
- · Self-enrolled at any time
- Asynchronous except for 1:1 virtual support appointments (via Microsoft Teams) with a Missouri Online instructional or media designer
- 3 hours each (for a total of 9 hours for recertification)
